1. Please read the general rules in front of this book. They apply to all departments. All OPEN sheep classes will show at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday.
 2. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL 4:00 P.M., Wednesday, July 19 and not later than 8:00 a.m. Thursday, July 20.
 3. Animals in this department shall be released after 12:00 noon, Monday, July 24.
 4. Feed and water troughs must be furnished by exhibitors.
 5. Entry fee shall be \$6.00 per entry in each class except Champion Classes.
 6. Pen rent shall be \$4.00 per head.
 7. All fees must be paid at time of entry.
 8. All sheep must be docked.
 9. All animals, except wethers and market ewe lambs, are to be purebred and registered in name of exhibitor.
 10. In case of disputes, the Superintendent's decision shall be final.
 11. Out-of-State Sheep are to be accompanied by an entry permit and a CVI.
 12. Illinois Sheep must have a CVI and include that "The sheep listed above were not exhibiting clinical signs of scrapie at the time of examination". Owner must also state on the CVI that the animals are not scrapie positive, suspect, high-risk, or exposed and are not from an infected source or exposed flock.
 13. Intermediate ram and ewe lamb classes will be born between Sept. 1 of previous year and Jan. 31 of current year. Junior lambs on or after Feb. 1 of current year.
 14. All Carcass and Wether Lambs must show no sign of testicular tissue or they will be disqualified.
 15. All Carcass and Wether Show Lambs must be weighted to be eligible to show. Check with Superintendents for time of weigh-in. Two chances to weigh will be allowed.
 16. A young flock shall consist of 1 Ram (yearling or ram lamb), 1 yearling Ewe, and 1 Ewe lamb.

17. A pen of breeding lambs consists of 3 head (both sexes represented).
 18. All wethers must weigh 80 pounds or more.
 19. Best 4 Head can be Rams and/or Ewes.
 20. No dogs will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
 21. Market ewe lambs cannot be shown in breeding classes.
 22. No more than two monies will be paid in any one premium numbers. i. e. You may show up to 14 wethers as long as there are no more than 2 in each weight division.
 23. Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.
 24. **Any exhibitor washing an animal in an inappropriate spot other than a washrack will forfeit all their premiums.**
 25. **ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIR GROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING BY 8:00 AM THURSDAY TO FREE UP PARKING.**

COSTUME LEAD CLASS

1. Open to anyone 14 years and under.
2. Animals may be ewe lambs, yearling ewes or wethers and they must be trimmed and fitted for show.
3. Entrants must wear a costume and lead their ewe or wether by a halter.
4. Entries will close the same time as the Open Class Sheep Show entries.
5. Animals and exhibitors will be subject to all general fair rules and those of the sheep department.

1. The general rules of the fair shall apply in the department.
 2. Feed and water troughs must be furnished by the exhibitor.
 3. No self feeders or water hoses will be allowed in the hog barn.
 4. An entry fee of \$6.00 must be paid for each entry number.
 5. Pens will be rented at \$8.50 per pen, maximum of 3 pigs per pen. **The superintendents will assign and restrict pens on a space available basis.** If requested pens not available, pen rent will be refunded.
 6. All pigs shall be farrowed on or after January 1st and before April 1st.
 7. Alleys and pens are to be kept clean and free from all debris.
 8. All animals must be accompanied with health papers and same to be shown to the superintendent in charge or to their assistants before unloading animals for exhibition. **All swine will no longer require blood testing for pseudorabies and brucellosis in the state of Illinois.**
 9. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL after 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 19 and prior to 8:00 a.m., July 20.
 10. BEFORE UNLOADING check in with superintendents with your health papers and the superintendents will assign the exhibitors their pens. Superintendents will assign ALL pens.
 11. Hogs shall be released from the grounds at 12:00 noon on Monday, July 24.
 12. All barrows and gilts will weigh only on Wednesday, July 19. No re-weighs.
 13. ALL PUREBRED AND CROSSBRED PIGS must be ear notched but not fresh notched. No fresh ear notches will be allowed.
 14. All barrows and crossbred gilt classes will be determined by weight. **All purebred gilts must be weighed and will be shown according to age.** For example, a crossbred barrow would be entered as Class No. G403 and a XB Gilt would be entered as Class No. 401 only. The letter classification will be determined after weighing and then posted in Swine Barn.
 15. To facilitate clean out, hogs must be out of the barn by 4 p.m.
 16. Exhibitors are responsible for tearing down pens and stacking gates.
 17. Pens for feed, supplies, etc. will be assigned by the superintendent on a space available basis.
 18. No dogs allowed on the fairgrounds.
 19. **Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.**
 20. All animals shown in Junior Shows (i.e. individual, herd or flock classes) shown must be the property of the boys or girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in 4-H, Open Show and Junior Show, they shall be entered & shown under the same exhibitor's name. Hogs must be shown by the same person whose name is on the entry blank..

21. **All hogs are required to be washed prior to the coming to the fair.**

1. Barrows must have been nominated, ear notched and tattooed before they are 37 days old. Premiere barrows must be farrowed property of the exhibitor. Pigs cannot weigh more than the equivalent of 1.0 pounds per day of age when tattooed. An official nomination form must be presented at time of weighing. One exhibitor may tattoo 15 head but exhibit only one. Barrows must have been farrowed property of the exhibitor.
2. All carcass barrows will be weighted at 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 20.
3. Pigs must be farrowed on or after January 15, 2017 for the Iroquois County Fair.
4. Pigs must be farrowed on or after February 10, 2017 for the Illinois State Fair.
5. **Entry Fee for will be \$6.00 Live & \$6.00 Carcass (No Pen Rent Required).**  
**You must entry both classes G441 & G442.**
6. HEALTH PAPERS ARE REQUIRED. NO blood test required.
7. Entries will be placed on basis of a combined carcass merit and pounds of carcass per day of age score. Pigs will show at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, July 20.
8. To be eligible for awards, all carcasses must meet the following minimum standards:
  - A. Hot carcass weight of at least 144 pounds.
  - B. Backfat, length, and loin eye area standards based on carcass weight as follows:

In addition all carcasses must meet the quality score of a least 2 (on a scale of 1 to 5) for color and firmness.
9. The judge will place the live animals on the hoof and then the top twenty will be slaughtered and carcasses placed according to above standard and rate-of -gain score. The exhibitor will be responsible for their carcasses.
10. Live class will be judged on Thursday, July 20 at 8:00 a.m.

1. The general rules of the Fair shall apply to this department.
2. Exhibits must be in place by 8:00 a.m., Thursday, July 20, except eggs, should be brought in on Friday by 8:00 a.m.
3. **NO LIVESTOCK CAN BE UNLOADED UNTIL AFTER 4:00 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, JULY 19.** Exhibits shall be released any time after 12:00 noon, July 24.
4. Entry fee, \$1.50 per entry; pen rent \$1.50 per bird. All fees must be paid at time of making entry. Entries should be made with Fair Secretary, Sam Ochs, Box 301, Crescent City, IL.
5. Indicate on entry blank number of cages needed and size (large or small).
6. American Standard Book of Perfection will be the judging guideline.
7. Feed and water containers to be provided by exhibitors.
8. Birds used in pens may be used in individual classes if banded so as to indicate individual to be used.
9. A pen shall consist of 2 females and 1 male except bantams, ducks, geese, pigeons, quail, pheasants, turkeys and guineas (which will be 1 pair, both sexes represented). Minimum age of all poultry is 8 weeks except fryer pens, maximum age 2 years.
10. Not responsible for theft.
11. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLY WITH ALL GENERAL HEALTH RULES.**
12. Upon admission to a show, all entries shall be examined by an accredited veterinarian employed by the management of the show or by an authorized State poultry inspector who shall also receive and examine all health certificates necessary for admission of birds to a show.
13. The judge reserves the right to eliminate immature birds.
14. Birds must be watered and fed every day by exhibitor.
15. Exhibitors must be present at show time to receive ribbons. Must be present at 8:00 a.m. Birds will be judged in cages.
16. Order of show will be posted.
17. Each exhibitor may show as many breeds as they want but are limited to a maximum of only 2 entries per class number.
18. All Market birds must be hatched after January 1st. These birds may not be shown in any other class.
19. A broiler fryer pen shall consist of 3 cockerels or 3 pullets weighing under 4 pounds. A roaster pen shall consist of 3 cockerel or 3 pullets weighing over 4 pounds.
20. Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.
21. If you have a question about your breed when entering contact the superintendent; **NO BREED** changes will be made after July 11.

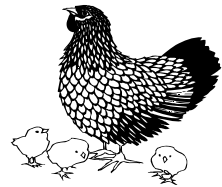
