1. The general rules of the Fair apply in the department.
 2. All animals must conform to "Cattle for Exhibition" following the general rules.
ALL OUT OF STATE STEERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A TB TEST.
 3. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL AFTER 4:00 P.M.,
Wednesday, July 19 and not later than 8:00 A.M., Thursday, July 20.
 4. Animals will be released at 12:00 noon, Monday, July 24.
 5. Feed and water troughs must be furnished by exhibitor. All animals are to remain in tents or barn until 7:00 p.m.
 6. Entry fee shall be \$9.00 per entry in each class shown.
 7. Stall fee shall be \$15.00 per head. **Exhibitor must bring their own bedding. No straw or bark will be allowed.** All cow-calf classes stall fee will be \$30.00. **Fees must accompany entry.**
 8. All cattle exhibited in the Breeding Classes must be purebred with registration papers with the exception of crossbred animals. Superintendent will check all registration papers.
 9. No exhibitor will be permitted to show more than two entries in any breeding or steer class.
 10. Mail entries to Sam Ochs, Box 301, Crescent City, IL, prior to Tuesday, July 11.
 11. **Registration papers with tattoo numbers must accompany all animals at the Fair, except steers and crossbreds.**
 12. **Tattoo numbers are to be placed on the entry blank under description of animal. This rule will be strictly enforced.** 1st and 2nd place winners in each class must be prepared to produce proper pedigree to correspond with the tattoo of the animal shown. If exhibitor is unable to produce above evidence he shall forfeit his premium and the third place animal will be eligible to show for Reserve Champion.
 13. No steer shall be shown regardless of birthdate - that does not have all of its milk teeth in place and no permanent teeth showing or evidence thereof.
 14. Age classifications of beef cattle listed in the general rules.
 15. No grooming chutes allowed in beef barn.
 16. Best of 3 head by one exhibitor.
Pair of Calves - one Bull Calf and one Heifer Calf owned by one exhibitor.
Pair of Yearlings - one Jr. or Summer Yearling Heifer owned by one exhibitor.
Cow Calf - cow and offspring any age owned by one exhibitor.
 17. Livestock exhibitors desiring to use a portable generator during the fair must meet the rules set forth by the state Fire Marshall and the Iroquois County Fair Board. No generators will be permitted without first registering it with the fair secretary and securing a permit.
 18. Only 1 fan per 3 head will be allowed.
 19. Exhibitors must clean stall & tie-outs before leaving the fairgrounds after the livestock sale.
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20. Stalls will be assigned by the Department Superintendent and will be 4 feet per stall fee paid. **Additional space may be purchased in 4' increments @ \$15.00 per space as long as space is available. A maximum of 2 additional spaces may be purchases per exhibitor. All additional space must be accompanied with fees and postmarked by July 11 so that adequate sized tents can be ordered. No refunds.**
 21. Show order will be as printed in book.
 22. All animals (i.e., individual, herd or flock classes) shown in Junior Shows must be the property of the boys or girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and Junior Show, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name (for example, the father is not permitted to show an animal in the open class and the son or daughter show the same animal in the Junior Show).
 23. Any pair or groups animals must be registered to one exhibitor.
 24. Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.
 25. In the Cow/Calf classes, the cow is only eligible for exhibition in that class. In other words, the cow may be shown only one time.
 26. Any exhibitor washing an animal in an inappropriate spot other than a washrack will forfeit all their premiums.
 27. Superintendent will have final discretion for space based on cattle present & stalls available. Any stalls that are not occupied with an animal will be assessed at the rate of \$15 per 4' increment.
 28. **Once an animal is unloaded from the trailer and stalled, they may not be put back on the trailer until the end of the fair or they will be disqualified and forfeit all premiums.**
 29. **ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIR GROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING BY 8:00 AM THURSDAY TO FREE UP PARKING.**

1. Please read the general rules in front of this book. They apply to all departments.
2. **NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL AFTER 4:00 P.M., Wednesday, July 19 and not later than 8:00 a.m., Thursday, July 20.**
3. Animals will be released after 12:00 noon, Monday, July 24. **NO Exceptions.**
4. All cattle must conform to "Cattle for Exhibition" following the general rules.
5. All animals must be accompanied with health papers and same be shown to the superintendent in charge or to his assistants before unloading animals for exhibition.
6. Entry fee shall be \$9.00 per entry in each class. Stall fee shall be \$8.50 per head. These fees must accompany entry.
7. Entries close at 5:00 P.M., Tuesday, July 11.
8. Registration papers must accompany all purebred animals at the fair. No registration papers required for Grade Dairy. Superintendent will check registration papers.
Registration papers must be on the grounds at all times.
9. All entries must be checked in and out with Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent of the department.
10. Any dairy animal that is in production shall show in the production class regardless of age.
11. No exhibitor will be paid no more than two monies in any one class.
12. **ALL EXHIBITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HELP CLEAN OUT BARNs.**
13. A head must be from the exhibitor.
 - a. Dam and Daughter/Produce of dam
 - b. Pair of Females any Age

DRAFT GATE CLOSSES 15 MINUTES AFTER 1ST CALL FOR CLASS

1. **All draft entries are pre-entered.** All fees and entry blanks should be mailed to Iroquois County Fair, Box 301, Crescent City, Illinois 60928 prior to Tuesday, July 11. Only entries postmarked on or before July 11th will be accepted. **NO entries will be taken on show day.**
2. Each exhibitor must pay \$7.50 entry fee per draft halter class, \$10.00 entry fee per draft hitch class. Stall of \$5.00 per head will be charged. Miniature horses reserve stalls per head. Must be sent in with entry fees. Miniature entry fees for halter classes are \$5.00 per class. Jumping, Driving & Costume classes entry fee will be \$7.50 per class.
3. Each exhibitor must purchase an exhibitor ticket for \$12.00. Senior citizen that are showing may purchase a Senior Exhibitor Ticket for \$7.50. (You must be 65 years or older to qualify.) Addition helpers must purchase daily admission ticket for \$7.50.
4. No exhibitor will be permitted to show more than two entries in any one class (premium number).
5. Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.
6. General rules of the Iroquois County Fair apply to all exhibitor.
7. No dogs will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
8. Illinois Equine (horses, ponies, mules, etc.) - (Exhibition or Race) Equine 12 months and older participating in an advertised equine event ("Advertised Equine event" means a show, rodeo, sale, auction, exhibition, trail ride, or horse fair, that is posted or media promoted) shall be accompanied by a negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia/E.I.A (Coggins/Celisa) conducted within one (1) year. A health certificate is not required for Illinois Equine.
Out-of-State Equine - must be accompanied by an entry permit. All horses and other equidae shall be accompanied by a CVI issued within thirty (30) days prior to entry.
9. Exhibitor may not use the same horse in Ladies Cart Class & Men's Cart Class.
10. **Exhibitor will be required to provide the Superintendent with a non-returnable copy of their coggins test.**
12. **Registration papers for all purebred animals must available for examination.**
13. No straw will be allowed. Must furnish own bedding.
