If you bring your camper in on Sunday or Monday, please do not run your AC until you arrive to stay. You may, of course, run your refrigerator.

Dear Camper:

This year's fair dates are July 15-20, 2025

Camper locations will be issued on the following basis:

1. Postmark on completed camper application **(with fees)**
2. Size and length of your camper
3. Available space

**Notice: Campers CANNOT be removed BETWEEN 2-6 PM on SUNDAY JULY 20 DURING LIVESTOCK DISMISSAL TIME. Campers can be removed at any other time during the fair. Anyone leaving during those hours will lose camping privileges for 2 years!**

Please complete the camper application and return it with proper fees **by June 15, 2025.** **After this date, we will open unpaid spots to new campers.** **Camper spots are not transferable.**

All camper spots will be **\$175.00 and will include one parking permit.** Campers have increased in size, so parking has become congested. Your vehicle **must** fit into **YOUR** space between the lines, even with the parking permit or it will **have to be parked in the general parking lots.** **Only one permit will be issued! No extra parking by tie-outs or barns or empty camping spots. There are very limited spots open for 42 ft campers.**

**Campers may be brought onto the fairgrounds beginning at 9:00 A.M. on Sunday July 13, 2024.** The \$175.00 camping rate covers Sunday, July 13 - Monday July 21. **Absolutely no campers will be allowed to enter until 9:00 A.M. on Sunday July 13<sup>th</sup>** without express permission from the fair office. Any camper disobeying this rule will lose their camping privileges. There is a \$35.00/day additional camper fee for those wishing to stay after July 21<sup>st</sup> or per day, if staying less than the whole fair. Do not dump grey water on the ground.

No Active Livestock Trailers are allowed in the East Campground, Livestock or box trailers that have been converted into living quarters may be used in the campgrounds.

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**Please remember that no fires are allowed on the campground.**

**We no longer have a black water dumping station. We are again working with Hiltz Septic. They will be available for dumping on Thursday and then again on Sunday. You must prepay for this service. Payment must be made with your camper application. On Wednesday June 16<sup>th</sup> flags will be ready for pick up at the fair office. These must be displayed at the roadside of your lot by 7:00 a.m. the morning of your scheduled service, so it is easily seen by their driver.**

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**Reminder that someone over the age of 21 must stay in the camper and is responsible for anyone under the age of 21 residing there and their actions.**

If you are not using your space this year, please let us know as soon as possible. Your signature also means that you have read and agreed to all the rules stated in this letter.

Stickers will be mailed to you upon the receipt of completed application and fees and assignment of locations. If there are any changes to your mailing label please note.
