1. General Rules of Fair apply. Please see 2022 Livestock Exhibition Regulations in front of the Fair Book.
2. Illinois Equine (horses, ponies, mules, etc.) - (Exhibition or Race) Equine 12 months and older participating in an advertised equine event ("Advertised equine event" means a show, rodeo, exhibition, trail ride, or horse fair, that is posted or media promoted) shall be accompanied by a negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia/E.I.A. (Coggins/Celisa) conducted within one (1) year. A health certificate is not required for Illinois Equine.
3. A non-returnable copy of your Coggins test must be turned in to the superintendent.
4. All out-of-state equine are to be accompanied by an entry permit. Permits are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week by calling (217)782-4944.
5. Each exhibitor must purchase an exhibitor's ticket - \$12.00. A gate admission of \$5.00 will be charged to all over 5 years. This will be credited on each exhibitor's ticket purchased. **Social Security Number and complete mailing address required on ALL entry blanks or premiums will not be paid.**
6. Dress attire – Western attire for all Western classes, English attire for English classes and Gaming classes collared shirts. **NO BALL CAPS, NO TENNIS SHOES, NO TANK TOPS AND SLEEVELESS ONLY WITH A COLLAR.** Contest riders are not required to wear a hat.
7. Pony or horse must be serviceably sound, well-groomed and equipment clean. No undo abuse or roughness to pony or horse. **NO HITTING IN FRONT OF THE CINCH. NO PROFANE LANGUAGE USED WHILE IN THE SHOW RING.** All exhibitors ride at their own risk. Judge's decision is final.
8. All exhibitors participating at this horse show have the responsibility of being familiar with the rules governed by either ILBRA Rules or show committee that apply to each class. Check rules at entry booth.
9. No entry fees refunded. Anyone responsible for any type of disturbance or argument in or around show ring will be barred from further showing. No alcoholic beverages allowed on fairgrounds.
10. Ponies may be measured if deemed necessary.
11. An exhibitor may only receive 2 monies per class.

1. The general rules of the Junior Show apply in this section.
  2. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry. Stall fee - \$15.00 per head.
  3. Each exhibitor may show only one horse or pony in each premium number. Show will be held rain or shine.
  4. Horse and Pony records must be on a year-round basis.
  5. Each exhibitor is required to own, feed, care for, and train horse or pony exhibited.
  6. Mare or gelding may be either purebred or grade.
  7. All breeds will show together.
  8. No dogs allowed on fairgrounds.
  9. Any equine that is not sound (lame, open wounds, hernias, malnutrition, etc.) will not be able to be on the fairgrounds for the Iroquois County Fair. Superintendents have the right for any animal to be vet checked and excused should there be any discrepancies.
  10. Pine shavings are the ONLY acceptable bedding materials.
  11. ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIR GROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING TO FREE UP PARKING.
- \*\*\*PREMISE ID is recommended on ALL Livestock entries.
