1. Please read the Open & Junior General Rules. They apply to all departments.
2. A fee of \$1.00 must be paid on all entries.
3. When bringing exhibits to the fair, report to the Superintendent in charge of the department.
4. Do not enter previous prize-winning canned goods.
5. All canned fruits and vegetables and meat must be in clear, standard quart or pint jars unless otherwise indicated - all jellies and preserves in clear standard pint, jelly, or similar jars. All jars should be labeled with contents & date processed. (Date should be put on can lid with permanent marker) Contents should be listed on back of entry tag. The judge may open any jar if there be a need.
6. Exhibitors may make a maximum of TWO (2) entries per premium number. Junior Show exhibitors must have a separate entry for all entries in the open class departments.
7. Dinner rolls, sweet rolls & doughnuts to be displayed on 9" plates - 3 to a plate.
8. Cookies and candy are to be displayed on a small paper plate - 3 cookies or 3 pieces of candy to a plate. ATTACH ALL TAGS TO PAPER PLATES
9. Decorated cakes and wedding cakes may be mocks done on styrofoam, cake pans, etc. They are judged strictly on decorations. Wedding cakes are not to exceed 15" in diameter, including base, and 26" high, including top decorations.
10. All persons, except those necessary in assisting the judges, will be excluded while judging is in progress.
11. Jellies and jams should be processed in a boiling water bath, with standard two-piece lids that are top sealed. Do not use paraffin to seal jellies and jams or they will be disqualified.
12. A whole cake must be exhibited with minimum size of 8 x 8 on a cardboard base or in a disposable pan.
13. Complete meal is to be a display of canned meat, fruit and vegetable in standard quart or pint jars with a menu card.

1. Cookies, rolls and candy are to be displayed 3 on small paper plate in clear plastic bags. Bread loaves are displayed one on a large paper plate in a clear plastic bag. Pies are to be in disposable containers.
2. Tags should be taped or stapled to plate or jar, not the plastic bag.
 1. Decorated cake - see Open Class Culinary rule #9.
 2. Entry \$1.00 per exhibit.

3. Separate exhibits MUST be made for open class or 4-H but you may exhibit two entries for each class listed below.
4. Decorated items judged on display only. (will not be tasted)
5. No plastic decorations on cakes/cupcakes. Must be decorated with edible items.
6. Edible art using non-perishable foods, candy dried fruits & vegetables, nuts, popcorn etc. Be creative. Base or container may be non-edible. Total display no larger than 16" x 16".
7. Canned item – see Open Class Culinary rule number 5.
