

## **General Open and Junior Goat Department Rules**

1. Please read and follow the Open & Junior Livestock General Rules of the fair.
2. All purebred Dairy animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name. Papers will be checked. All Meat Goats will be considered Commercial for the Open Meat Goat Show. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE IDENTIFIED BY A SCRAPIE TAG OR APPROPRIATE TATOO.**
3. Entry fee shall be \$6.00 per entry for Open Class and \$4.00 per entry for Junior Class. Exhibitor may make two entries in each class. Mail entries to Entries, PO Box 301, Crescent City, IL 60928. Entries close on July 6 at 5:00 pm.
4. Pen fee shall be \$10.00 per pen with a maximum of 3 animals per pen.
5. No bucks allowed. Wethers shall be castrated or banded prior to May 1. No horned dairy animals.
6. **NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL 7:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 19 and not later than 12:00 pm.** All animals will remain for the duration of the fair and will be released after 6:00 pm, Sunday, July 24.
7. Health regulations of the State of Illinois must be followed, and health papers will be collected.
8. Dairy animals entered in Get of Sire and Produce of Dam classes **MUST ALSO** be shown in their appropriate age classes to be shown as part of a pair or group.
9. Dairy Goats will be judged on Saturday, July 23 at 8:00 am. The Meat Goat Show will begin shortly after the Dairy Goat Show.
10. Any animals which possess any percentage of meat bloodline must be shown in the meat classes **ONLY**.
11. All meat and dairy wethers must be born on or after October 1st, 2021. There should be **NO VISIBLE SIGN OF A SCROTUM** and all castrations must be healed or the animal will not be allowed to show. Horns will be allowed based on breed preference.
12. Wood chips will be the only bedding allowed. **NO STRAW.**
13. Items used and stored in goat barn will be at the discretion of the goat superintendents.
14. **ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING TO FREE UP PARKING.**
15. **DO NOT ENTER CHAMPION CLASSES.**
16. **Open Goats required dates of ownership are:**  
**Milking Does and Meat Breeding Does – January 1 of current year**  
**Kids and yearlings not in milk and Wethers and Market Does – May 15 of current year**
17. **Junior Goats required dates of ownership are:**  
Milking does - January 1 of current year  
Kids and Yearling not in milk and wether - by May 15 of current year  
Wether must be born - on or after October 1, 2021
