Cage sizes are: Small 22 inches wide 24 inches deep 22 inches tall door 15 inches wide 14 inches tall. Large cages are 24 inches tall 24 inches deep 30 inches tall

Entry Fee will be \$2.00 per entry. No Pen Fee Premiums will be divided between the number of exhibitors in each class. Guidelines for displays are listed below

Junior Show Display will consist of Name of Breed, Picture(s) of your bird, Description of Breed, how you care for your project, why you chose this breed for your project

For second entry for the same class the display will consist of another breed in your category with these topics to discuss: Name of Breed, Picture(s) of the breed, Description of Breed, how you care for this breed, why you chose this breed for your project

Open Show Display consist of educational displays on one of the following topics, How to Breed, Common Diseases, Asiatic Flu Virus, Management Practices, Nutrition, Egg Production, Meat Production, Economic Impact of virus on Poultry Industry, how to cook poultry, how to cut poultry, Nutritional Value, how to promote Poultry Industry.

For second entry in same class choose a different topic from open show list.

Livestock Sale – Due to the Illinois State Department of Agriculture cancelling the live Poultry Show, poultry exhibitors will not be able to sell on the sale as there will not be Champions to sell.
